





## **Statement in Support of Ethics Complaint**

This statement is made in connection with the Ethics Complaint regarding the conduct of Assistant Sheriff Richard "Rick" Marshall with the Nye County Sheriff's Office ("NCSO").

Like many other counties this time of year, Nye County is in the throes of a hotly contested race for the position of Nye County Sheriff. The current incumbent running for re-election is Sheriff Anthony "Tony" DeMeo. His opponent is Nevada Highway Patrolman Scott Cobel. Asst. Sheriff Marshall is a direct subordinate of the incumbent Sheriff DeMeo.

While I can understand that every citizen is entitled to campaign and support their choice for various political offices, it is difficult for me to fathom that it is permissible for a sitting public employee to use their position to directly campaign for their immediate supervisor completely unchecked while acting in their public duties.

Specifically I am concerned that Asst. Sheriff Marshall may have violated NRS 281A.400 (7) by using governmental time, property, equipment or other facility to benefit his personal interest in seeing that his direct supervisor is re-elected. In addition, I am concerned that Asst. Sheriff Marshall may have violated NRS 281A.520 by using government resources to campaign on behalf of his boss.

The crux of this complaint focuses on Asst. Sheriff Marshall's prolific and voluminous posting on the social media website called FaceBook in a direct effort to actively campaign for Sheriff DeMeo. His primary medium for this campaigning is a page on FaceBook called Positive Pahrump ("Positive") (see Exhibit 1). Positive is a forum run by a local Pahrump resident with over 2,000 users. The site openly allows people to post information about events and the like that concern Pahrump residents. It also serves as forum for people to exchange political dialogue. Asst. Sheriff Marshall has an active FaceBook account and is a member of Positive (see Exhibit 2).

One of the settings in FaceBook is the option to select a personal photo to personalize your postings that make the poster readily identifiable. Asst. Sheriff Marshall has selected a clear photo of a campaign sign that reads: "Re-Elect Sheriff Tony DeMeo" as seen in Exhibit 2. Every time Asst. Sheriff Marshall posts a message anywhere on FaceBook his campaigning efforts are clear that he wants you to: "Re-Elect Sheriff Tony DeMeo".

Asst. Sheriff Marshall made approximately 60 posts to the Positive site in the month of October (see Exhibit 3). Asst. Sheriff Marshall made approximately 16 posts to the Positive site in the month of September (see Exhibit 4). Asst. Sheriff Marshall made approximately 9 posts to the Positive site in the month of August (see Exhibit 5). Asst. Sheriff Marshall made approximately 9 posts to the Positive site in the month of July (see Exhibit 6). These posts were made seven days a week at various hours of the day. Many made in time periods of what would be considered normal working hours for a public


employee. There were many other posts from Asst. Sheriff Marshall from May and June but I only have so much time to go back and pull all of his numerous postings.

The most unsettling aspect of Asst. Sheriff Marshall's numerous posts are the ones that I have flagged. These posts either discuss official NCSO functions, departmental policies or active cases. Asst. Sheriff Marshall offers his insight, official NCSO policy and opinion all the while reminding visitors to the Positive site reading these official communications to: "Re-Elect Sheriff Tony DeMeo" with his campaign sign for his boss.

I am concerned that Asst. Sheriff Marshall has crossed the line from private citizen making is political choices public to public employee proactively campaigning for his direct superior possibly while using government resources to do so.

I am hopeful that the Board will investigate this matter and take the necessary steps to prevent it from happening again.



OPINION

Appellant appeals, contending, among other things, that the warrantless search of the vehicle was illegal. We conclude that the search was valid because it was supported by probable cause and because EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES existed to justify the search.

FACTS

Nevada State Trooper Scott Cobel heard a report over his police radio that shots had been fired at the Saddle West Hotel & Casino in Primm, Nevada. Trooper Cobel immediately responded to the casino where he was flagged down by a security guard, who gave a license plate number and description of the vehicle in which the shooting suspects had left. Trooper Cobel proceeded southbound on State Route 160 until he caught up with the vehicle and pulled it over. Cobel drew his weapon and ordered the four occupants of the vehicle to raise their hands. At the time of the stop, appellant was sitting in the back seat of the vehicle, behind the driver. With the assistance of another Trooper, Cobel then conducted a felony traffic stop, wherein he ordered each of the vehicle's occupants at gunpoint to step out of the car, one at a time. As each occupant stepped out of the vehicle, Cobel performed a quick pat-down search, handcuffed the individual, and sat him or her down on the side of the road.

Trooper Cobel then searched the vehicle for weapons. Cobel testified that when he searched the vehicle, officer safety was not an issue because the four suspects were temporarily restrained and had been patted down for weapons.

Beneath the driver's seat, Cobel found a Beretta semiautomatic handgun ("Beretta"). The Beretta was located behind a metal bar which adjusts the seat, with the barrel pointed towards the front of the car and the hammer pulled back. Cobel also found marijuana in a black duffel bag. A casino security guard reported seeing appellant outside the casino carrying a black duffel bag. Methamphetamine and a second handgun were also recovered by police, as well as a third handgun which was thrown from the vehicle prior to the stop, but appellant was only convicted on charges related to the Beretta and the marijuana.

The district court conducted a hearing outside the presence of the jury in order to make a determination on appellant's suppression motion. After hearing testimony from Trooper Cobel, the district court denied the suppression motion, concluding as follows:

Knowing that there was likely a gun and it wasn't found on the persons stopped, it was only reasonable for the officers to conclude that the gun or guns would likely be in the car. It was unreasonable under these factual circumstances to not search for weapons.

In any event this Court would find based on the likelihood of firearms there has been an adequate showing of exigent circumstances to search for firearms.

Ultimately, the jury returned guilty verdicts on one count of being an ex-felon in possession of a firearm (for the Beretta found under the driver's seat) and one count of possession of a controlled substance (for the marijuana found in the black duffel bag).

DISCUSSION

We conclude that the imminent arrest of appellant and the other occupants of the vehicle, following a pursuit from the scene of a crime, would similarly leave the vehicle "on the roadside subject to a police inventory search and later impoundment, creating a sufficient exigent circumstance" to satisfy the second prong of the automobile exception. *Id.* As in *Fletcher*, it would likewise in this case be "unreasonable to require the police to remain at the scene of the arrest pending the arrival of a warrant or assign an officer to accompany the tow truck to an impound yard pending the arrival of a warrant." *Id.* We therefore conclude that under the circumstances of this case there existed sufficient exigent circumstances to justify a warrantless search of the vehicle.

The warrantless search of the vehicle was supported by probable cause and the roadside stop of the vehicle following pursuit from the scene of a crime created exigent circumstances to justify the search. Therefore, we conclude that the district court did not err in admitting the evidence found during the search.

Likewise, any rational trier of fact could conclude that the marijuana in the black duffel bag belonged to appellant, because of (1) his voluntary statements identifying the bag as his and (2) because the casino security guard saw appellant carrying a black duffel bag outside the casino.

CONCLUSION

We conclude that the district court did not err in admitting the evidence



obtained in the warrantless search of the vehicle in which appellant was a passenger because the search was supported by probable cause and exigent circumstances existed in that the search occurred contemporaneously with the roadside arrest of appellant and the other occupants of the vehicle following pursuit from the scene of a crime. We conclude that appellant's remaining contentions also lack merit. Accordingly, we affirm appellant's conviction.

3. Appellant makes this argument in connection with his assertion that cumulative error warrants a new trial. Because the record is devoid of any error, appellant's cumulative error contention lacks merit. SHEARING and AGOSTI, JJ., concur.



OK - a little research showed that the originator of the message is from Fallon Nevada, a city in Churchill County Nevada and is from August 2008.

So, lets look at NRS 202.3657 Application for permit; eligibility...; denial or revocation of permit. It states: 1. Any person who is a resident of this State may apply to the sheriff of the county in which he or she resides for a permit on a form prescribed by regulation of the Department.

So if the person resides in Churchill County, they may apply to the sheriff of Churchill County. Nye County is different than Churchill County. See the difference - Nye / Churchill

So, if the person establishes residency in Nye County, then they may apply to the sheriff of Nye County and at that time provide the required documentation for issuance of a permit as stated: 2. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the sheriff shall issue a permit for revolvers, one or more specific semiautomatic firearms, or for revolvers and one or more specific semiautomatic firearms, as applicable, to any person who is qualified to possess the firearm or firearms to which the application pertains under state and federal law, who submits an application in accordance with the provisions of this section and who:

- (a) Is 21 years of age or older;
- (b) Is not prohibited from possessing a firearm pursuant to NRS 202.360; and
- (c) Demonstrates competence with revolvers, each specific semiautomatic firearm to which the application pertains, or revolvers and each such semiautomatic firearm, as applicable, by presenting a certificate or other documentation to the sheriff which shows that the applicant:
  - (1) Successfully completed a course in firearm safety approved by a sheriff in this State; or
  - (2) Successfully completed a course in firearm safety offered by a federal, state or local law enforcement agency, community college, university or national organization that certifies instructors in firearm safety.

So, until they become a resident of Nye County, Sheriff DeMeo is correct.

It is posted on the Nye County website, www.nycocounty.net, page 16 is the final approved budget. Or simply call Pam Webster Assistant County manager to verify it. And, Scott, I have NEVER told you the budget was 19million and that 4 million went to pay raises.

Second - in some instances warrantless entry's are permissible. For example, in Minnesota v. Olson, the United States Supreme Court held that warrantless entry into private premises may be allowed when officers have probable cause to believe one or more of the following circumstances are present:

- In hot pursuit of a fleeing felon;
- Medical emergency (like someone slumped over against the wall not responding to pounding on a front door or the ringing of a telephone);
- To prevent the imminent destruction of evidence;
- To prevent a suspect's escape; or
- To alleviate the risk of danger to the police or to other persons inside or outside the dwelling (taking into consideration the gravity of the crime and likelihood that the suspect is armed).

There are other warrantless entry's that have been approved by the courts.

Third - as for the shootings, I fail to see how that is Sheriff DeMeo's fault. Perhaps Scott could elaborate on this. Crime is not out of control as Scott states. The men and women of the Nye County Sheriff's Office do a tremendous job with the amount of manpower allotted by the Commissioners. Additionally, there are none better trained anywhere, period. Scott claims to have a work schedule that will put more officers on the streets, yet he is so concerned about public safety that he has refused to share this magic schedule with us, even though I have personally asked for it no less than five times.

Four - We have more than 2 narcotics officers, Scott knows this and is simply distorting the numbers, much like he distorted the budget numbers and the jail bed counts and the supervisor / officer ratio and the In Car Cameras and who knows what else.

Five - again distorting the numbers, the jail is a 224 bed facility. It is being built with "Build America Bonds", which cannot be used for the things Scott alludes to. Another fact that Scott left out is that the jail is being built in wings, so the un-used wings can be shut down until they are needed. Additionally, because of the way it is being built, staffing levels are decreased from a traditional jail setting. 
