NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT ON A REGULATION

The Nevada Commission on Ethics of the State of Nevada, 704 W. Nye Lane, Suite 204, Carson City, NV 89703, Phone No. 775-687-5469, is proposing the adoption, amendment and repeal of regulations pertaining to **Chapter 281A of the Nevada Administrative Code**. A public hearing has been set for the following date, time and locations:

February 11, 2011 at 9:30 a.m.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulations that pertain to chapter 281A of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of [NRS 233B.0603](#):

1. The regulations are needed to update the regulations to reflect the changes enacted by Senate Bill 160 of the 2009 Legislative Session; amend the procedures for advisory hearings governing the conduct of former public officers and employees; revise terminology governing requests for opinion submitted by third-parties or on the Commission's own motion; and other matters properly relating thereto.

2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved. See paragraph 1.

3. The regulation will have no economic effect on the business which it regulates or on the public.
4. The cost of enforcing the regulation will not add materially to the agency's already approved biennial budget.
5. The regulation does not duplicate or overlap any regulations of other federal, state or local governmental agencies.
6. The regulation is not required pursuant to federal law.
7. The regulation includes provisions which are no more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity.
8. The proposed regulation does not establish a new fee or increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Commission on Ethics may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to Caren Jenkins, Esq., Executive Director, Nevada Commission on Ethics, 704 W. Nye Lane, Suite 204, Carson City, NV 89703. Written submissions must be received at the Commission office on or before January 26, 2011. If no person directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Commission on Ethics may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulation to be adopted will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation will be available at the Commission on Ethics office at 704 W. Nye Lane, Suite 204, Carson City, NV 89703, and, in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations, which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to [NRS 233B.0653](#), and on the Internet at <http://www.leg.state.nv.us/>. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
