The Nevada Commission on Ethics will hold a final public hearing and act upon regulations to the *Nevada Administrative Code* on October 8, 2003. The Commission will receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulations that pertain to Chapter 281 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the final amendment of regulations that pertain to the Nevada ethics in government law presently under *Nevada Administrative Code* sections 281.005 through 281.242, and presented as [LCB File No. R111-03](#).

Legislation passed by the 2003 Nevada Legislature made numerous changes to the ethics in government statutes (*Nevada Revised Statutes* 281.411 through 281.581). Staff recommendations and public workshops resulted in regulation revisions reflecting new statutory revisions, as well as reviewing and updating the NAC through the 10-year rule review process required under NRS 233B.050(1)(e).

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada Commission on Ethics may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views, or arguments, in written form, to Ms. Stacy M. Jennings, Executive Director, Nevada Commission on Ethics, 3476 Executive Pointe Way, Suite 16, Carson City, NV 89706. Written submissions or proposals must be received by the Nevada Commission on Ethics on or before September 19, 2003. If no person who is directly interested in the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Commission may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions and subsequently adopt the regulations.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the Commission, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.

A copy of this notice and the regulations to be adopted will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation to be adopted will be available at:
