The Commission was notified on March 12, 2013 that Senate Bill 228 governing revisions to the Commission's statutes set forth in NRS 281A was introduced in the Nevada Senate and scheduled to be considered by the Senate Committee on Legislative Operations and Elections on Tuesday, March 19, 2013 at 8:00 a.m. The Commission was not able to schedule and notice a meeting of the Commission or its Legislative Subcommittee within the relevant time frames set forth in NRS 241 to consider or take action regarding the provisions of Senate Bill 228 before the Nevada Legislature's scheduled hearing. Pursuant to NRS 241.020(2), the Commission posted this notice as soon as practicable before its March 19, 2013 meeting.
