Some highlights from the report:

- 41 Advisory Opinions requested
- 102 Complaint Cases filed
- 120 Complaint Case resolved
- Over 1,400 public officers and employees trained
- Over \$23,000 in penalties collected

Executive Director Ross Armstrong noted: "We resolved a record number of complaint cases and trained a record number of public officials in 2023. These efforts to increase the productivity and effectiveness of the Commission's team will continue into 2024."
