Nye County Ethics Case Ends with Stipulated Agreement

CARSON CITY, NEVADA (November 17, 2022) – On November 16, the Nevada Commission on Ethics approved a stipulated agreement with former Nye County Treasurer John Prudhont. Earlier this year an ethics complaint was filed against Mr. Prudhont alleging misuse of county resources. The stipulated agreement includes an admission of one non-willful violation of the Ethics Law with dismissal of the other allegations. Prudhont has agreed to complete ethics training and will be formally admonished as part of the agreement.

The same day, the Review Panels for the Commission reviewed several cases and made final determinations in the following cases:

In re Delgado case 22-094C (City of Reno)
Determination: Dismissal

In re Soto case 22-051C (City of Reno)
Determination: Dismissal with Letter of Caution
