LAS VEGAS, NEVADA (November 26, 2025) The Nevada Commission on Ethics (NCOE) is bringing ethics education directly to public servants across rural Nevada with an in-person Rural Outreach Tour December 1–3. The tour provides guidance, training, and resources to help local officials navigate Nevada’s Ethics in Government Law.
